Pre-employment driver licence check to be performed, with annual endorsement checks.	FM Technician	Prior to commencing work
Driver to be given company vehicle / transport policies.	FM Technician	Prior to commencing work
Driver training, including online to be undertaken.	FM Technician	Prior to commencing work
Driver to monitor health, including eyesight and to inform company if any concerns noted.	FM Technician	Prior to commencing work
Driver to be assessed for suitability of vehicle, including ability to reach pedals etc.	FM Technician	Prior to commencing work
All company vehicles to have specific regular and routine inspections, checks and tests in accordance with statutory requirements and manufacturers recommendations.	FM Technician	At required times
Vehicles to be maintained in a clean and safe condition.	FM Technician	At all times
Any defects noted are to be reported to FM helpdesk as soon as possible.	FM Technician	At all times
Any load to be secured to prevent further injury if involved in an accident.	FM Technician	At all times
Using a mobile phone whilst driving is illegal and strictly prohibited.	FM Technician	At all times
Plan the journey and if need be, take into account: length of journey, weather, time of day travelling, road restrictions, etc.	FM Technician	At all times
