Additional Measures:

Further Measures	Person Responsible	Date for Completion
Where possible, only operate in car parks or road ways out of busy traffic periods.	FM Technician	Prior to commencing work
Where possible, erect warning signage at strategic locations to alert drivers of your presence.	FM Technician	Prior to commencing work
Where possible, barrier off areas using traffic cones etc.	FM Technician	Prior to commencing work
Ensure there is sufficient lighting for you and drivers to see you, especially in hours of darkness.	FM Technician	Prior to commencing work
Ensure good housekeeping to prevent slips, trips and falls.	FM Technician	At all times
Ensure clothing is in good condition and suitable for the task and weather.	FM Technician	At all times
If you have to work outside in inclement weather, ensure work breaks are in a warm, dry area and hot drinks to prevent dehydration are taken.	FM Technician	At all times
Anti-slip footwear to be worn.	FM Technician	At all times
If there is any doubt concerning the task or safety, stop work and clarify.	FM Technician	At all times
